The Dispensary of Hope at Saint Thomas West Hospital is designed to assist eligible patients with their medication needs through the use of donated generic drugs and brand name sample drugs or safety-net drugs based on **income verification and needs**. TennCare recipients are accepted, but Plaza Pharmacy must utilize TennCare benefits first. TennCare beneficiaries are not eligible for free samples but can access the safety-net list of medications.***Please note: If patient has prescription insurance coverage or is Medicare eligible, they are not eligible for Dispensary of Hope program.

- Patient **MUST** complete an application. Applications are available on-line at www.sths.com/Pages/Medical-Services/Pharmacy-Services/Dispensary-of-Hope/Contact-Information.aspx, or at STH Plaza Pharmacy
- The following items are **MANDATORY** in order to receive services:

1. Social Security Card and/or Photo Identification

Types Accepted: Drivers License, ID card, Employment ID, Passport, Visa Debit Card with photo, or any photo ID from originating country

2. Proof of Income

Types Accepted: Tax Return, Paycheck stub, unemployment check, statement from social security office for SS, SSDI, SSI, AFDC, PENSIONS, or FOOD STAMP LETTER

- Application and Proof of Income **MUST** be brought to Pharmacy Social Worker or faxed to social worker at 615-222-5802 for income verification
- Controlled substances, cold/allergy meds, and OTC smoking cessation products are **NOT COVERED**
- Donated generic drugs and brand name sample drugs are **FREE**
- Safety-net drugs are \$1.00 or \$3.00 per prescription
